The reaction of the fans who snapped up tickets for his five shows at the INEC in Killarney, Co Kerry, this month showed that Donegal's favourite son has lost none of his old magic.

His decision to step off the conveyor belt had come after a period of trauma in his personal life during which his wife, Majella, was diagnosed and treated for breast cancer.

Daniel also suffered the heartache of losing his beloved mother, Julia, who reared him on her own from the age of six, when his father died suddenly.

Although putting his touring on hold, Daniel took up new offers during the break, including the challenge of competing on Strictly Come Dancing. His reality TV career took off when he teamed up with Majella on a B&B tour of Ireland.

Daniel and Majella's B&B Roadtrip became a smash hit for UTV Ireland and RTE has now taken it up for a new series.

The top entertainer then disappeared for five months with Majella on a world cruise. Daniel says he has returned with a new zest for touring after taking time off from a relentless schedule of travel and performing spanning more than 30 years.

"My first night back reminded me just how much I love the stage, the singing and all the fun we have as a band when I'm up there performing," Daniel says.

"In Killarney this month there was an incredible buzz in the venue every night, and then to discover that fans had travelled from as far away as Australia and America, as well as the UK and all over Ireland, was just amazing. Some people went to all five shows!"

'It's like riding a bike' - Daniel O'Donnell on his comeback

Thousands of Daniel O'Donnell fans are descending on the Kingdom from all over the world as the country star makes his comeback on Tuesday night after an 18-month sabbatical.

The veteran singer, 54, has been rehearsing in recent days with his new band as they tune up for a five-night run at the INEC, Killarney.

Fans are jetting in from all over the world including the UK, the US and Australia to see their idol return to the stage for the first time after his extended break from music.

The Donegal crooner pressed pause on his career in 2014 to spend quality time with wife Majella, 56, who was recovering from breast cancer.

As part of their break, the couple went on a four-month luxury world cruise taking in 26 countries across the South Pacific and Asia earlier this year.

Daniel said they relished the uninterrupted time together, adding that "it was just what we needed".

Fans have been taking to Daniel's Facebook page in their droves to welcome him back and express their excitement at his return.

"Fantastic. Travelling from Australia to enjoy your show," wrote one fan who is planning to celebrate her 50th wedding anniversary at tonight's concert.

"Daniel, really looking forward to seeing you in Killarney this weekend with my sisters Kathleen and Barbara xx," wrote a devotee travelling from Portsmouth, England.

"Case all packed, can't wait," added another from Fife, Scotland.

Demand for Daniel is at an all-time high as he returns to the stage, with hundreds of new fans joining the old since his appearances last year on BBC1's 'Strictly Come Dancing' and the home-grown 'Daniel and Majella's B&B Road Trip'.

Thousands of tickets costing €47.50 for 'Daniel's White Christmas' – a three-night festive run at Dublin's Convention Centre – sold out in just 20 minutes.

Meanwhile, the singer's Killarney gigs will be followed by an extensive tour of the UK and the US in September and October.
